**APPOINTMENT OF HAZARDOUS MATERIALS  
INCIDENT COMMAND AGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, RCW 70.136.030 directs the governing body of fire protection districts to designate a Hazardous Materials Incident Command Agency within the district boundaries; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners has considered the training, manpower, expertise, and equipment of agencies available within the district as well as the provisions of the Uniform Fire Code and other applicable codes and regulations; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board finds that in the event of a hazardous materials incident within the district that the district would be notified of the incident and would in all probability be the first public agency to respond with emergency personnel and equipment to the scene of the incident; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board finds that it is in the best interests of the district and the residents of the district that the district qualify as a Hazardous Materials Incident Command Agency under Chapter 70.136 RCW;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of \_\_\_\_\_ County Fire Protection District No. \_\_\_\_\_, that the district is hereby designated as the Hazardous Materials Incident Command Agency to operate within the boundaries of the district; and,

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners that the chief of the district, or in the absence of the chief, the officer in command of the district personnel and equipment that respond to a hazardous materials incident, is designated as the representative of the district as that term is defined in RCW 70.136.020(8).
