1. Construct a firebreak _____ wide to mineral earth around the material to be burned.
2. Conduct burn between the hours of _____ and _____.
3. Maintain a minimum number of _____ personnel at the burn site.

The permittee shall comply with the terms and conditions of the permit, and shall maintain a responsible person in charge of the fire at all times, who shall maintain the fire under control, not permit it to spread to other property or structures, and extinguish the fire when the authorized burning is completed or when directed by district personnel. The possession of a permit shall not relieve the permittee from liability for damages resulting from the fire for which the permittee may otherwise be liable. (RCW 52.12.104)

Permit holder agrees to comply with all other applicable Washington State and Local Clean Air Authority Regulations and to obtain all other permits required by other governmental agencies.

If the burn is to be conducted on more than one day during the term of the permit, the approval of the District must be obtained on each day that the burn will be conducted prior to the starting of the burn. Notification and prior approval of the District for each day may be obtained by telephone.

The violation of or failure to comply with any provision of Chapter 52.12 RCW pertaining to fire permits, or of any term or condition of the permit is a misdemeanor. (RCW 52.12.106)

If a person starts a fire without a permit or if a permit holder fails to comply with any provisions of Chapter 52.12 RCW pertaining to fire permits, or of any term or condition of the permit, and as a result of that failure the District is required to suppress a fire, the person or permit holder is liable to the District to reimburse it for the cost of its fire suppression services. (RCW 52.12.108)

This permit may be cancelled at any time by the issuing District.
